

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **How do I join the show team?**

You can join the show team by becoming a show team member.

- **What are the requirements for being a show team member?**

Students interested in becoming a member must:

- Pay membership dues
- Attend regular meetings
- Assist in feeding the species they are showing
- Work the animals
- Have a show team sponsor
- Assist at the annual steer and heifer show
- Participate with all club activities

- **Do I have to be an Agriculture major to join the team?**

All SFA students can become members.

- **When are the meetings?**

Meetings are scheduled differently each semester. Bulletins will be posted in the Agriculture building or you may contact the show team advisor.

- **What species does the show team exhibit?**

The team has shown cattle, swine, and sheep.

- **Can we show other species?**

Yes, if there is interest.

- **What shows does the team attend?**

San Antonio Livestock Show and Rodeo, Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo, East Texas State Fair, State Fair of Texas, as well as Eight breed conferences

- **Can I show my own animal?**

We limit the animals to university owned.

- **Do I have to try out?**

The team is open to anyone interested in showing, even if you don't have show experience.

- **What do I receive for showing the animal?**

All premiums won exhibiting the animals belongs to the farm.
